## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-21 by adding a new subsection to section 9 thereof to appropriate funds for Capacity Building purposes; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 1 Section 9 of Public Law No. 14-21 is 2 here amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 9.
