A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$31,447,701 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; to establish a capital and human resource development budget, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from Section 1. 2 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia the sum of 3 \$31,447,701, or so much thereof as many be necessary, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National 4 5 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, 6 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and capital and human resource development programs of the National Government 7 8 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006. The sum appropriated herein shall be 9 10 apportioned as follows:

11 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or from the personnel budget line items shall not be permitted. 12 The 13 President may reprogram up to 10% to or from, whichever is less, 14 from the funds appropriated to each department and office in section 2 (Operating expenses of the Executive Branch). 15 16 Programming of funds within a department or agency shall be effected by the head of such department by specifying in writing 17 18 to the Secretary of Finance and Administration, FSM National Government the accounts for which funding is either increased or 19 decreased. 20

21 Section 12. <u>Allotment and management of funds and lapse</u> 22 date.

23 (1) General Provisions.

24 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be25 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in

1 accordance with applicable law, including, but not 2 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the 3 amended Compact of Free Association between the United 4 States Government and the Government of the Federated 5 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. (b) The allottees shall be responsible for 6 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be 7 8 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in 9 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. 10 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated 11 12 by this act are as follows: 13 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall 14 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall 15 16 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States 17 of Micronesia; 18 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall 19 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the 20 Federated States of Micronesia; 21 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall 22 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of 23 Micronesia: 24 (e) Section 6 through 9 - the allottee of these 25 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of

Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of 1 2 section 8 through 9 of this act, the allottee shall be: 3 (i) section 8 subsection (7) (a) through (d) 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice 5 of the respective state; 6 (ii) section 9(1)(a) through (f) - the 7 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the 8 College of Micronesia-FSM. 9 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to 10 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September 30, 2006, EXCEPT the funds appropriated 11 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse. 12 13 Section 13.
