(2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated 18 19 by this act are as follows: (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall 20 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; 21 22 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall 2.3 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States 24 of Micronesia;

6	9(1)(f) and 9(10)(a) shall lapse as of March 31, 2007.

10	Section 9. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
12	becoming law without such approval.
