A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-50, as amended, by amending section 13 to provide funding for contractual services to complete the headquarters of the Tuna Commission and Official Residences, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 12-50, as amended by Public Law No. 12-53, 12-74, 13-1, 13-17 and 14-65, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 13.
