A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$50,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of funding funeral expenses for First President of the Federated States of Micronesia Tosiwo Nakayama, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 4 September 30, 2007 for the purpose of funding funeral expenses for 5 First President of the Federated States of Micronesia, Tosiwo 6 Nakayama. The funds appropriated under section 1 of this act shall 7 be apportioned as follows:

8 (1) Funeral Expenses for First President of the Federated States of Micronesia, Tosiwo Nakayama\$ 9 50,000 10 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, 11 12 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 13 1979 and the amended Compact of Free Association between the 14 United States Government and the Government of the Federated 15 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The allottee 16 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much 17 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose 18 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in 19

1 excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds 2 appropriated under this act shall be President of the Federated 3 States of Micronesia. The authority of the allottee to obligate 4 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on 30 September, 2008. 5 Section 3.
