A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend chapter 15 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 13-75, by amending sections 1503, 1504, 1508, 1509, and 1511 thereof.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1503 of title 55 of the Code of the 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as enacted by Public Law No. 13-75, is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 1503. Appointment and removal of Board 4 5 Members. 6 (1)The Board shall consist of seven [m] Members, 7 appointed in the following manner: The Head of the Office of Compact 8 9 Management, appointed as provided in section 207 of 10 title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia; 11 12 Two Members shall be appointed by the 13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia on the 14 advice and consent of Congress; and 15 One [m] Member shall be appointed by each 16 State in such manner as may be established by State law. 17 (2) Members shall be appointed with consideration

1 (3) Each Member shall serve at the pleasure of its Appointing Authority, however, no Member's term shall be 2 less than one year <u>unless removed by the Appointing</u> 3 4 Authority for cause. A vacancy on the Board may be filled, pending 5 appointment of a new Member: 6 7 in the case of a Member appointed pursuant to subsection (1)(b), by the President or his designee; 8 9 or 10 (b) in the case of a Member appointed pursuant to 11 subsection (1)(c) by the Governor of the appointing 12 State or his designee. (5) A Member appointed pursuant to subsection 1(b) may 13 14 be removed from the Board by the President. [resolution and a two-thirds vote of Congress.] A Member appointed 15 by a State may be removed as may be provided by the law 16 of that State. 17 18 Members shall not be entitled to compensation for 19 their position on the Board. All related expenses 20 incurred by a Member shall be the responsibility of the 21 Appointing Authority, except that travel to and from official meetings may be paid for by the National 22 23 Government." 24 Section 2. Section 1504 of title 55 of the Code of the

75, is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 1504. Powers and responsibilities of the 2 3 Board. The Board shall have the following powers and 4 5 responsibilities: 6 (1) To formulate guidelines for the JEMCO 7 Representatives to follow in their communications of Compact matters at JEMCO meetings; [-] 8 9 (2) To support the JEMCO Representatives in matters 10 relating to the Compact; [-] 11 (3) To identify, consider and formulate positions, in 12 the best interests of the Federated States of Micronesia, with regard to issues to be addressed by 13 14 JEMCO and other issues relating to the management of the Compact, provided that the Board shall not alter the 15 16 proposals for Compact Sector Grant Awards submitted by the President to JEMCO on behalf of the National 17 18 Government or the States, the Infrastructure Development Plan or Strategic Plan, as_such terms are defined in the 19 20 Compact, submitted by the Federated States of Micronesia 2.1 to JEMCO; (4) To coordinate the submission to JEMCO and the 2.2

information as may be needed to support proposals to

- (5) To ensure that all reports and other documents required by the Compact are submitted on a timely basis;
- (6) To provide oversight of the implementation of the provisions of the Compact by the National Government and each of the State Governments and their respective agencies, and as the Board deems appropriate, including the conducting of investigations to ensure that the National Government and each of the State Governments is in compliance with all terms of the Compact;
- (7) To direct the work[, in conjunction with the

 President,] of the Office of Compact Management with the

 concurrence, and subject to the ultimate authority, of

 the President;
- (8) To establish procedures or rules for conducting the business of the Board; [and]
- (9) To report to the President, Congress and each of the States concerning the activities of the Board, the actions of JEMCO and the Trust Fund Committee, and other significant matters relating to the Compact: [-] and
- (10) To use its best efforts to ensure that the obligations of the Federated States of Micronesia under the Compact are satisfied and the rights of the Federated States of Micronesia under the Compact are preserved and upheld."

1	Section 3. Section 1508 of title 55 of the Code of the
2	Federated States of Micronesia, as enacted by Public Law No. 13-
3	75, is hereby amended to read as follows::
4	"Section 1508. Appointment of JEMCO and Trust Fund
5	Committee Representatives.
6	(1) The Member appointed pursuant to subsection
7	1503(1) (a) of this chapter shall serve as <u>both</u> a JEMCO
8	Representative and a representative of the Federated
9	States of Micronesia on the Trust Fund Committee.
L 0	(2) The President shall appoint one of the Members
L1	appointed pursuant to subsection 1503(1)(b) to serve as
L2	a JEMCO Representative. The President shall appoint the
L3	same or the other Member appointed pursuant to
L 4	subsection 1503(1)(b) to serve as a representative of
L 5	the Federated States of Micronesia on the Trust Fund
L 6	Committee.
L 7	(3) JEMCO Representatives and representatives of the
L 8	Federated States of Micronesia on the Trust Fund
L 9	Committee shall serve a two-year term, or such other
20	term as may be provided in the Compact.
21	(4) JEMCO Representatives and representatives of the
22	Federated States of Micronesia on the Trust Fund
23	<pre>Committee may be re-appointed.</pre>
24	(5) In the event of a vacancy or absence of a JEMCO

Representative or representative of the Federated States

1 of Micronesia on the Trust Fund Committee, the Member appointed pursuant to subsection 1503(1)(b) who is not a 2 JEMCO Representative or, as the case may be, a Trust 3 Fund Committee representative shall become the JEMCO 4 Representative or Trust Fund Committee representative 5 6 until such vacancy is filled or during such absence. 7 [(6) JEMCO Representatives shall also serve as the representatives of the Federated States of Micronesia on 8 the Trust Fund Committee.]" 9 Section 4. Section 1509 of title 55 of the Code of the 10 11 Federated States of Micronesia, is hereby amended to read as 12 follows: "Section 1509. Office of Compact Management. 13 [In addition to] The Office of Compact management shall 14 assist and advise[ing] the President on Compact 15 16 Matters.[7] In addition, pursuant to the directives of 17 the President the Office of Compact Management shall 18 provide assistance to [and take direction from] the Board. The Board may also give direction to the Office 19 20 of Compact Management on Compact matters with the 21 concurrence, and subject to the ultimate authority, of the President. The duties that may be asked of the 2.2 23 Office of Compact Management by the Board shall include 24 the following: 25 (1) To be principally responsible, on behalf of the

2	communications with JEMCO and the United States with
3	regard to JEMCO and Compact matters;
4	(2) [Under the direction of the Board,] [t] \underline{T} 0 gather, develop

10	(6) To do such further and additional things as may be directed
11	Section 5. Section 1511 of title 55 of the Code of the
12	Federated States of Micronesia, is hereby amended to read as
13	follows:
14	"Section 1511. Employees of the Office of Compact
15	<u>Management</u> . [Every e] \underline{E} mployees of the Office of
16	Compact Management [with the exception of the Head],
17	shall be subject to the provisions of title 52 of the
18	Code of the Federated States of Micronesia: the
19	National Public Service System Act, with the exception
20	of the Head of the Office of Compact Management and
21	those employees the Head determines that, because of
22	the degree of expertise or special knowledge required
23	and the nature of the services to be performed, it
24	would not be practical to obtain personnel to perform
25	such services through normal public service recruitment

1	procedures."
2	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
3	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
4	becoming law without such approval.
