## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by amending section 1 thereof to deposit certain funds appropriated therein in the fund entitled "Public Projects for Chuuk Election District No. 5" within the General Fund, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
