## AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$22,790,897 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; to establish a capital and human resource development budget, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 3 Section 12. <u>Allotment and management of funds and lapse</u>
- 4 date.

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- 5 (1) General Provisions.
  - (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the amended Compact of Free Association between the United States Government and the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and its related agreements.
    - (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated.
    - (2) <u>Allottees</u>. The allottee of the funds appropriated by this act are as follows:
    - (a) Section 2 the allottee of these funds shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
    - (b) Section 3 the allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;
  - (c) Section 4 the allottee of these funds shall

1	be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
2	Federated States of Micronesia;
3	(d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall
4	be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of

6	9(1)(f) and 9(10)(a) shall lapse as of March 31, 2007.
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8	Section 13. This act shall become law upon approval by the
