

A RESOLUTION

To shorten the Sixth Regular Session of the Fourteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1       WHEREAS, the Sixth Regular Session of the Fourteenth Congress  
2 of the Federated States of Micronesia was convened on January 10,  
3 2007 and was scheduled to continue for 20 consecutive days  
4 thereafter; and

5       WHEREAS, the Congress may, by a majority vote of all the  
6 Members, and pursuant to section 202 of title 3 of the Code of the  
7 Federated States of Micronesia, shorten the session by resolution;  
8 now, therefore,

9       BE IT RESOLVED by the Fourteenth Congress of the Federated  
10 States of Micronesia, Sixth Regular Session, 2007, that the  
11 Congress hereby shortens this Regular Session of the Fourteenth  
12 Congress to Fifteen days so as to adjourn on January 24, 2007;

13       BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this  
14 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States  
15 of Micronesia.
