A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 203 thereof, to properly place the Project Management Unit for the Compact Infrastructure Grants under the appropriate Department at the FSM National Government, and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 203 of title 2 of the Code of the 2 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-3 21, 6-62, 7-97, 10-55, 13-75 and 15-09, is hereby further amended 4 to read as follows: 5 "Section 203. Departments. (1) There shall be the following departments which 6 7 shall be responsible for major programs or 8 administrative support areas in the Government of the 9 Federated States of Micronesia: 10 (a) Department of Resources and Development; 11 (b) Department of Finance and Administration; 12 (c) Department of Foreign Affairs; 13 (d) Department of Health and Social Affairs; 14 (e) Department of Justice; 15 (f) Department of Transportation, Communication 16 and Infrastructure, which shall contain among other unit, <u>a Project Management Unit for the Compact</u> 17 Infrastructure Grants; and 18 19 (q) Department of Education.

(2) The administrative head of each department shall 1 2 be designated as a "Secretary". (3) The administrative head of each office shall be 3 4 designated as a "Director". 5 (4) Succession. 6 (a) Any reference to a previously existing 7 department, office or division thereof shall apply to 8 the appropriate successor entity. 9 (b) Any reference to any office or employee of an 10 entity referred to in subsection (4)(a) of this section 11 shall be construed as applying to the person holding the same or most similar position in the appropriate 12 successor entity." 13 14 Section 2.
