A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate [\$41,065,121] \$33,321,789 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; to extend the lapse date for funds appropriated in fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 from supplementary education grant (SEG), and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Shall read as follows: To appropriate the sum of [\$41,065,121] \$33,321,789 from the General Fund of the Federated 2 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 3 2009, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of

the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its 5

herein, \$789,832 shall be deemed to come from funds available 8

\$100,000 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 12

amended Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be 13

14 deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from

15 the infrastructure sector; and \$0 shall be deemed to come from

16 funds available under the supplemental education grant (SEG). The

The authority of the allottee to obligate 15 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of 16 September 30, 2009, EXCEPT the funds appropriated under 17 section 9 of this act shall not lapse.
