A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-55, by amending its title, sections 1, 2, 5, and 7 thereof, in order to appropriate an additional amount of \$435,999 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
