## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26 and 15-33, by amending sections 1, 2, 6, 8, and 9 thereof, in order to appropriate an additional \$1,247,130 from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.
