

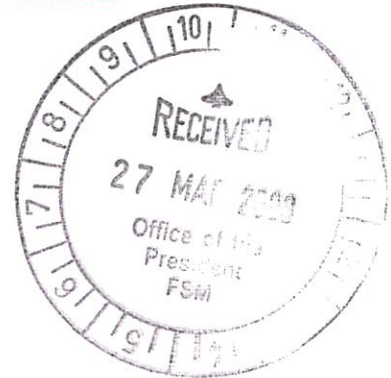

PUBLIC LAW No. 15-32

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia, a sum of \$3,780,000 for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the four States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much thereof is
2 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States
3 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 for
4 the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in each
5 State of the Federated States of Micronesia. The fund shall be
6 apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member of
7 Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT an increase of \$300,000 is for
8 Yap State.

10 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

11 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
12 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
13 including, but not limited to the Financial Management Acts of
14 each of the State, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
15 amended Compact of Free Association between the United States
16 Government and the Government of the Federated States of
17 Micronesia and its related agreements. The allottee shall be
18 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
20 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
21 sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
22 subsections (4)(a), (d), (e) and (f) of section 1 of this act
23 shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Project. The
24 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 1, 3, 4(b) and
25 4(c) of section 1 of this act shall be the President of the

1 Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under subsection (2) of section 1 of this act shall
3 be the Governor of the State of Yap. The funds appropriated by
4 this act shall remain available until fully expended.

5 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7 becoming law without such approval.
