#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32 by amending Sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs for the States of Chuuk, Yap, Pohnpei and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

23	All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
24	administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
25	including, but not limited to the Financial Management Acts of

- 1 each of the State, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
  2 amended Compact of Free Association between the United States
  3 Government and the Government of the Federated States of
  4 Micronesia and its related agreements. The allottee shall be
  5 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as
- 6 may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
- 7 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
- 8 sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
- 9 subsections (4)(a), (d), (e) and (f) of section 1 of this act
- 10 shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Project. The
- 11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 1, 3, 4(b) and
- 12 4(c) of section 1 of this act shall be the President of the
- 13 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of
- 14 funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section 1 of this act
- 15 shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The funds appropriated
- 16 by this act shall remain available until fully expended.
