

PUBLIC LAW No. 15-36

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32 by amending Sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs for the States of Chuuk, Yap, Pohnpei and Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much thereof
4 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
6 ending September 30, 2008 for the purpose of funding
7 public projects and social programs in each State of the
8 Federated States of Micronesia. The fund shall be
9 apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member
10 of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT an increase of
11 \$300,000 is for Yap State.

22 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.

23 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,

24 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,

25 including, but not limited to the Financial Management Acts of

1 each of the State, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
2 amended Compact of Free Association between the United States
3 Government and the Government of the Federated States of
4 Micronesia and its related agreements. The allottee shall be
5 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
7 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
8 sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
9 subsections (4)(a), (d), (e) and (f) of section 1 of this act
10 shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Project. The
11 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 1, 3, 4(b) and
12 4(c) of section 1 of this act shall be the President of the
13 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of
14 funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section 1 of this act
15 shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The funds appropriated
16 by this act shall remain available until fully expended.

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PUBLIC LAW No. 15-36

Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
