## AN ACT To amend sections 103 and 104 of title 36 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia; and for other purposes. 1 Section 1. Section 103, title 36 of the FSM Code is hereby 2 amended to read as follows: "Section 103. Application for charter - Article of 3 4 Incorporation. 5 (1) An association of persons seeking a charter as a 6 corporation shall submit for approval of the President 7 of the Federated States of Micronesia, or his designee, 8 articles of incorporation which shall provide as least 9 the following information: 10 (a) proposed name of the corporation; 11 (b) principal office or place of business; 12 (c) proposed duration; 13 (d) purposes; 14 (e) powers; 15 (f) capitalization; 16 (q) names of incorporations, which shall be one 17 or more; (h) number of directors, which shall be one or 18 19 more, and proposed officers; 20 (i) name(s) of director(s) and officers to serve 21 until first election;

(j) provisions of management, if any;								
(k) provisions for voting by members;								
(1) provisions for shareholding, if any;								
(m) disposition of financial surplus;								
(n) provisions for liquidation;								
(o) provisions for amendment of articles of								
incorporation.								
(2) An affidavit shall be submitted to the Office of								
the Registrar by the President and Secretary of the								
corporation as named in the articles of incorporation								
not later than sixty (60) days from the date of receipt								
of the certificate of incorporation. The affidavit								
shall be notarized by a duly authorized FSM notary.								
(3) Any other document(s) that require notarization								
shall be done by a duly authorized FSM notary."								
Section 2. Section 104, title 35 of FSM Code is hereby								
amended to read as follows:								
"Section 104. <u>Application for charter - Bylaws</u> . In								
addition to articles of incorporation, persons seeking a								
charter as a corporation may, at the discretion of the								
corporation, submit for approval of the President of the								
Federated States of Micronesia, or his designee,								
proposed bylaws governing the operation of the								
corporation."
