A RESOLUTION

To ratify the 1946 International Convention for the Regulation of Whaling.

- 1 WHEREAS, the history of whaling has been characterized as "over-
- 2 fishing" of one area after another and of one species of whale after
- 3 another to such an extent that it is essential to protect all species
- 4 of whale from further over-fishing; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the gigantic body of ocean connecting the islands of the
- 6 Federated States of Micronesia are blessed with a substantial number of
- 7 species of whale and unless some regulations are in place to regulate
- 8 their exploitation, the whales in the FSM waters will be on the list of
- 9 passengers going to extinction; and
- 10 WHEREAS, through appropriate regulations, whaling operations could
- 11 be confined to those species best able to sustain exploitation in order
- 12 to have an internal for recovery to certain species of whale now
- 13 depleted in number; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the International Convention for the Regulation of Waling
- 15 was signed on December 2, 1946, in Washington, D.C. for the
- 16 conservation of whale stocks and to make possible the orderly
- 17 development of the whaling industry; and pursuant to that Convention an
- 18 International Whaling Commission was created; and
- 19 WHEREAS, that Commission encourages, co-ordinates and funds whale
- 20 research, publish the results of scientific research and promotes

studies into related matter such as humaneness of the killing 2 operations; and 3 WHERES, membership in the Commission is open to any country in the 4 World that formally ratify the 1946 Convention; each member country is represented by a Commissioner, who is assisted by experts and advisers; 5 and the chairman and vice chairman of the Commission, who serves for a 6 7 three years term, are elected from among the Commissioners; and WHEREAS, the benefits to be derived from ratifying the 1946 8 Convention on the Regulation of Whaling outweigh any possible detriment that may arise there from; now, therefore 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated States of 11 Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2008, that the 1946 International 12 Convention on the Regulation of Whaling be, and the same hereby is, 13 14 ratified; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that duly certified copies of this 15 16 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia and to the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs. 17 18 Date: <u>9/24/08</u> Introduced by: /s/ Joe N.
