

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32, as amended, by amending Sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs for the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 15-36 and 15-44, is hereby further amended to
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much thereof
5 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7 ending September 30, 2008 for the purpose of funding
8 public projects and social programs in each State of the
9 Federated States of Micronesia. The fund shall be
10 apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member
11 of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT an increase of
12 \$300,000 is for Yap State.

9 PROVIDED THAT the allottee of this specific
 10 funding shall deposit the funds into the
 11 Special Funds within the General Fund of the
 12 Federated States of Micronesia for Chuuk
 13 Election District No. 5 established pursuant
 14 to Public Law No. 13-83."

15 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 15-32, as amended, by
 16 Public Law No. 15-36, is hereby further amended to read as
 17 follows:

18 "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 19 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 20 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 21 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 22 limited to the Financial Management Acts of each of the
 23 State, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
 24 amended Compact of Free Association between the United
 25 States Government and the Government of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The
2 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
3 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
4 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
5 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
6 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
7 under subsections (4) (a), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of
8 section 1 of this act shall be the Chuuk State
9 Commission on Improvement Project. The allottee of
10 funds appropriated under subsections 1, 3, and 4(b) [~~and~~
11 ~~4(e)~~] of section 1 of this act shall be the President of
12 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection (2) of
14 section 1 of this act shall be the Governor of the State
15 of Yap. The funds appropriated by this act shall remain
16 available until fully expended."

17 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
18 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
19 becoming law without such approval.
