

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Section 1 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for Election District No. 3, Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by Public Laws
2 No. 14-72, 14-82 and 14-91, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$2.1 million, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006 for projects
8 and programs in each state of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia. The funds appropriated under section 1 of
10 this act shall be apportioned on the basis of \$150,000
11 per member of Congress as follows:
