

A RESOLUTION

Approving Airport Improvement Program project grant agreements between the Federated States of Micronesia and the United States.

1           WHEREAS, the United States, acting on behalf of the United  
2 States Secretary of Transportation and through the Federal  
3 Aviation Administration, has offered the Federated States of  
4 Micronesia grants for Airport Improvement Program Project Nos. 3-  
5 64-0001-08, 3-64-0001-09, 3-64-0002-09, 3-64-0002-10, 3-64-0003-  
6 10, 03-64-0003-11, 3-64-0004-09 and 3-64-0004-10;

7           WHEREAS, Airport Improvement Program Project Nos. 3-64-0001-  
8 08, 3-64-0001-09, 3-64-0002-09, 3-64-0002-10, 3-64-0003-10, 3-64-  
9 00011, 3-64-0004-09, and 3-64-0004-10, will fund ninety-five  
10 percent (95%) of the costs of procuring design services for the  
11 construction of an Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting building and  
12 the rehabilitation of runway, taxiway and apron for the  
13 international airports in each state;

14           WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia, through the  
15 Secretary of Foreign Affairs, has accepted the eight  
16 aforementioned Airport Improvement Program project grants and  
17 executed agreements for each grant;

18           WHEREAS, these grants qualify as program funds received from  
19 the United States pursuant to sections 221(a), 221(c) and 224 of  
20 the Compact of Free Association, and each grant is for a sum that  
21 exceeds \$50,000;

1           WHEREAS, section 211 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated  
2 States of Micronesia requires Congressional approval by resolution  
3 of all program funds for \$50,000 or more received from the United  
4 States pursuant to sections 221(a), 221(c) and 224 of the Compact  
5 of Free Association; and

6           WHEREAS, the eight aforementioned Airport Improvement Program  
7 project grant agreements also require that a resolution has been  
8 duly adopted as an official act of Congress;

9           BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated  
10 States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2007, that the grant  
11 agreement for Airport Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0001-08  
12 is hereby approved;

13           BE IT RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport  
14 Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0001-09 is hereby approved;

15           BE IT RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport  
16 Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0002-09 is hereby approved;

17           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport  
18 Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0002-10 is hereby approved;

19           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport  
20 Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0003-10 is hereby approved;

21           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport  
22 Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0003-11 is hereby approved;

23           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport  
24 Program Project No. 3-64-0004-09 is hereby approved;

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the grant agreement for Airport

1 Improvement Program Project No. 3-64-0004-10 is hereby approved;

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
4 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States  
5 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs,  
6 the Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications  
7 and Infrastructure and the Governor of each State.
