## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 21 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 203 and adding a new section 232 for the purpose of improving the Telecommunications services provided to the outer islands, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 203 of title 21 of the Code of the
2	Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as
3	follows:
4	"Section 203. Powers and responsibilities of the
5	Corporation.
6	(1) The Corporation has the following powers and
7	responsibilities:
8	$[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$ (a) to operate as the sole provider of all
9	telecommunications services, except with respect to
10	intra-state inter-island communications, and except
11	radio and television broadcasting, within the Federated
12	States of Micronesia and between points in the Federated
13	States of Micronesia and points outside thereof;
14	$[\frac{(2)}{(2)}]$ to operate and manage such services on the
15	basis of commercially accepted practices, treating all
16	users of telecommunications services on equitable terms
17	in accordance with its published tariffs, and requiring
18	all users to pay for the services provided;
19	$[\frac{(3)}{(c)}]$ to plan for the expansion and improvement of
20	telecommunications facilities and services;

1  $\left[\frac{(4)}{(4)}\right]$  (d) to the extent practicable, to expand 2 telecommunications services to areas and communities in 3 the Federated States of Micronesia that are presently 4 unserved or poorly served and to improve the quality, 5 reliability, and variety of services available to all users in a manner consistent with commercial 6 7 reasonableness and with promoting economic development, 8 the advancement of education and health care, and the 9 preservation of the cultural identity of the people of 10 the Federated States of Micronesia; 11  $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$  (e) to improve the telecommunications skills and 12 promote the telecommunications training of Micronesia 13 citizens who are employees of the Corporation;  $[\frac{(6)}{(1)}]$  to establish, publish, and implement a 14 structure of tariffs and rates for telecommunications 1.5 16 services calculated to ensure that, to the extent 17 practicable, adequate and equitable charges are imposed for services and that the tariff structure promotes the 18 19 increased use of telecommunications services; 20  $\left[\frac{7}{9}\right]$  (q) to invest all surplus revenues of the 21 Corporation in the expansion and improvement of 22 telecommunications facilities and services; 23  $\left[\frac{(8)}{(8)}\right]$  (h) to incur indebtedness for the purpose of expanding and improving telecommunications facilities, 24 25 to the extent and on such terms as are deemed

1	commercially reasonable by the Corporation;
2	$[\frac{(9)}{(1)}]$ to provide on a reimbursable basis emergency
3	telecommunications services to governments, individuals,
4	and entities in the Federated States of Micronesia; and
5	$[\frac{(10)}{(10)}]$ to represent the Federated States of
6	Micronesia with regard to telecommunications matters in
7	such international organizations and for fora in which
8	the Federated States of Micronesia is represented,
9	subject to the policy guidance of the Government of the
10	Federated States of Micronesia.
11	(2) No provision of subsection 1 of this section shall
12	be construed to limit the states' authority to develop
13	intra-state, inter-island communications networks.
14	Section 2. Title 21 of the Code of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding a new
16	Section 232 to read as follows:
17	"Section 232. Inter-island Communication Networks.
18	Notwithstanding Section 203 of this Chapter, the states
19	shall have the authority to establish inter-island
20	communications networks for the purpose of providing
21	intra-state, inter-island communications services.
