A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 16-07 to appropriate the "FSM Education Sector Grant - Fiscal Year 2010 - Amendment 1" grant of \$603,240 to the National Department of Education, to appropriate the "FSM Supplemental Education Grant - Fiscal Year 2009" grant of \$684,564 to the College of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-07, is hereby
