A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$4,200,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the four States of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$4,200,000, or so much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 4 September 30, 2011, for the purpose of funding public projects and
- 5 social programs in the four States of the Federated States of
- 6 Micronesia. The funds shall be apportioned on the basis of
- 7 \$300,000 per member of Congress as follows:

- 10 (3) State of Pohnpei 1,200,000

- 12 Section 2. <u>Allotment and management of funds and lapse date</u>.
- 13 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
- 14 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
- 15 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
- 16 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
- 17 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
- 18 the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are
- 19 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the

1 funds appropriated under this act shall be the President of the 2 Federated States of Micronesia. The funds appropriated by this 3 act shall remain available until fully expended. Section 3.
