I am pleased to inform you that I have designated the following Congressional Act as Public Law No. 16-76:

Congressional Act No. 16-75 "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-49, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-68, BY AMENDING THE TITLE AND SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 THEREOF, TO MODIFY THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PERVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATES OF POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND TO OFFER TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."
