AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$682,687 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, by amending sections 1, 2, 6 and 9 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, and 16-60, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by 2 Public Laws Nos. 16-48, 16-53, and 16-60, is hereby further 3 amended to read as follows:
