A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere sadness and condolences of the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the people of Japan for the suffering and destruction caused by the earthquake and tsunami of March 11, 2011. 1 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2011 a magnitude 9.0 earthquake struck off the coast of the city of Sendai, Miyagi Prefecture 2 3 in the Tohoku region of Japan; and WHEREAS, the earthquake triggered tsunami waves measuring 4 more than 30 feet which struck along the Tohoku region's 5 6 coastline and reached as far as 6 miles inland; and 7 WHEREAS, the nation of Japan has tragically lost over 7,000 of its dear citizens to the earthquake and tsunami and 8 has had thousands more injured; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the earthquake and tsunami wrought extensive 11 damage to infrastructure in the region, including damage and disruption to essential needs such as water service and 12 electricity production; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia recognizes the great efforts made by the Government 15 16 of Japan and the people of Japan to mitigate and contain the damage following this disaster and wishes all possible luck and 17 18 fortuity upon their continuing mitigation and recovery efforts; now, therefore 19
