A RESOLUTION

Approving the Foreign Fishing Agreement (the "Agreement") entered into between the National Oceanic Resource Management Authority (NORMA) and Luen Thai Fishing Venture, Ltd. (LTFV) dated November 24 and 27, 2010 for the purpose of licensing up to 120 long line fishing vessels to be based throughout the four states of the Federated States of Micronesia for a period of ten (10) years.

- 1 WHEREAS, pursuant to sections 105 and 405 of title 24 of
- 2 the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by
- 3 Public Law No. 12-34, the National Oceanic Resource Management
- 4 Authority (NORMA) is authorized to negotiate and enter into
- 5 access agreements on behalf of the Government of the Federated
- 6 States of Micronesia subject to approval of Congress; and
- 7 WHEREAS, NORMA and Luen Thai Fishing Venture, Ltd. have
- 8 had a long term fisheries relationship through the Micronesian
- 9 Fishing Venture, Inc. Agreement; and
- 10 WHEREAS, NORMA, on behalf of the Federated States of
- 11 Micronesia, has negotiated and entered into an Agreement for
- 12 Domestic Based Foreign Fishing Vessels with Luen Thai Fishing
- 13 Venture, Ltd. (LTFV) for a period of ten (10) years to take
- 14 effect upon approval by the Congress of the Federated States of
- 15 Micronesia; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the Agreement consists of minimum terms and
- 17 conditions for access applicable under title 24 of the Code of
- 18 the Federated States of Micronesia and regionally agreed
- 19 minimum terms and conditions for access; and

- 1 WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for licensing up to a
- 2 maximum of 120 long line fishing vessels categorized in two
- 3 size classes: less than 150 gross tons and greater than 150
- 4 gross tons for which the license fees for long line fishing
- 5 vessels that be less than 150 gross tons is \$11,000 per vessel
- 6 per annum, or \$4,000 per vessel per quarter, and for long line
- 7 fishing vessels that are greater than 150 gross tons is \$18,000
- 8 per vessel per annum, or \$6,000 per vessel per quarter, in
- 9 addition to a \$600 registration fee per vessel, an observer fee
- 10 of \$1,000 per vessel, and a \$500 management fee per vessel
- 11 payable each year; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Agreement requires that all the long line
- 13 fishing vessels shall be based and operating out of the
- 14 Federated States of Micronesia unless otherwise authorized by
- 15 NORMA and such Agreement will result in significant economic
- 16 benefits to accrue to the four states as a result of this
- 17 Agreement; and
- 18 WHEREAS, this Agreement, if approved by Congress,
- 19 supersedes the Micronesian Fishing Venture, Inc. agreement
- 20 currently being implemented; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Congress, pursuant to section 405 of title 24 of
- 22 the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, has
- 23 the authority to approve this Agreement; now, therefore,
- 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixteenth Congress of the Federated
- 25 States of Micronesia, Sixth Special Session, 2011, that the
