

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-30, by amending Section 1 thereof, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-30 is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$3,780,000, or so much thereof  
4 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the  
5 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year  
6 ending September 30, 2008 for the purpose of funding  
7 public projects and social programs in each State of  
8 the Federated States of Micronesia. The fund shall be  
9 apportioned on the basis of \$250,000 or less per member  
10 of Congress as follows, PROVIDED THAT an increase of  
11 \$300,000 is for Yap State.
