

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia a supplemental funding in the amount of \$2,633,632 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 6, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by Public Law No. 16-20, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 16-20, is hereby amended to read as follows:  
3           "Section 1. The title of this act is as follows: To  
4           appropriate the sum of \$39,200,411 from the General Fund  
5           of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
6           year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose of  
7           funding the operations of all branches of the National  
8           Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its  
9           agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and  
10          contributions; and for other purposes. Of the total  
11          amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,403,240 shall be  
12          deemed to come from funds available under the FSM  
13          Education Grant - Fiscal Year 2010 - Amended 1; \$684,564  
14          shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
15          FSM Supplemental Education Grant - Fiscal Year 2009;  
16          \$845,333 shall be deemed to come from funds available  
17          under the FSM Health Section Grant - Fiscal Year 2010;  
18          \$384,107 shall be deemed to come from funds available  
19          under the FSM Public Sector Capacity Building Grant -  
20          Fiscal Year 2010; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from

1 funds available under the FSM Private Section  
2 Development Sector Grant - Fiscal Year 2010; and \$-0-  
3 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
4 FSM Infrastructure Grant - Fiscal Year 2010. The sum  
5 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"
