

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia a supplemental funding in the total amount of \$764,615 for fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by Public Law Nos. 16-20 and 16-25, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 16-20 and 16-25, is hereby further
3 amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The title of this act is as follows: To
5 appropriate the sum of \$39,965,026 from the General Fund
6 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
7 year ending September 30, 2010, for the purpose of
8 funding the operations of all branches of the National
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
11 contributions; and for other purposes. Of the total
12 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,403,240 shall be
13 deemed to come from funds available under the FSM
14 Education Grant - Fiscal Year 2010 - Amendment 1;
15 \$684,564 shall be deemed to come from funds available
16 under the FSM Supplemental Education Grant - Fiscal Year
17 2009; \$845,333 shall be deemed to come from funds
18 available under the FSM Health Section Grant - Fiscal
19 Year 2010; \$384,107 shall be deemed to come from funds
20 available under the FSM Public Sector Capacity Building

1 Grant - Fiscal Year 2010; \$-0- shall be deemed to come
2 from funds available under the FSM Private Sector
3 Development Sector Grant - Fiscal Year 2010; and \$-0-
4 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
5 FSM Infrastructure Grant - Fiscal Year 2010. The sum
6 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"
