## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 6 and 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Law Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, to appropriate supplemental funding in the total amount of \$567,000, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Purpose. deemed to come from funds available under the amended 1 2 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt 3 of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the capacity building 5 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the private 7 sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the 9 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector. 10 11 Section 2.
