A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend title 40 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 108 thereof, to include physical education programs among the criteria for accrediting elementary and secondary schools, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 108 of title 40 of the Code of the
- 2 Federated States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 "Section 108. Accreditation of elementary and secondary schools.
- Criteria for accreditation. Criteria for 6 (1)7 accrediting elementary and secondary schools in the Federated States of Micronesia shall be established 8 9 by the Secretary of the Department of Education in cooperation and consultation with the State Directors 10 of Education, and shall include those factors 11 12 necessary to provide an adequate classroom 13 environment conducive to learning, including but not
- 15 (a) Philosophy, goals and objectives;

limited to the following:

- 16 (b) Organization;
- 17 (c) Staff and teachers;
- 18 (d) School plant and physical facilities;
- 19 (e) Library;

1	(f) Student counseling services;
2	(g) Curricular program;
3	(h) Co-curricular program;
4	(i) Physical education program;
5	(j) Community and parent involvement;
6	(j)(k) Finance;
7	$\frac{(k)}{(1)}$ Student-teacher ratio; and
8	$\frac{(1)}{(m)}$ Compliance with the minimum standards
9	established by and under this act.
10	(2) <u>Accreditation committee</u> . An accreditation
11	committee may be established by the Secretary to
12	evaluate elementary and secondary schools for
13	accreditation purposes.
14	(a) If established, this committee may be
15	temporary, intermittent, or standing.
16	(b) The accreditation committee shall recommend
17	to the Secretary whether a secondary school meets the
18	approved accreditation standards or not.
19	(c) A recommendation to issue a certificate of
20	accreditation will be made for those elementary and
21	secondary schools meeting the accreditation
22	standards.
23	(d) A recommendation for technical assistance
24	will be made for those elementary and secondary
25	schools not meeting the accreditation standards.

(3) Certificate of accreditation. The Secretary shall issue a National Certificate of Accreditation to respective elementary and secondary schools which substantially comply with accreditation standards, and which have a plan or program in effect to remedy any defects or shortcomings within an agreed upon period of time, based on appropriate recommendations from the accreditation committee.

- (4) <u>National-State consultation</u>. The Secretary shall consult with the respective State Directors of Education for appropriate technical assistance to be provided by both National and State Governments to the respective elementary and secondary schools based on appropriate recommendations from the accreditation committee.
- (5) National Special Certificate of Achievement.

 The Secretary shall issue a National Special

 Certificate of Achievement to elementary and

 secondary schools which comply with or exceed all FSM

 accreditation standards.
- (6) <u>Contingency as incentive</u>. In order to provide an incentive for the improvement of schools, the Secretary may make eligibility for certain categories of scholarship and other funds contingent upon obtaining certification or special certification, or
