A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$5,000,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, to offset effects of the next five years of decrement of Compact Funding for the administration of the governments of FSM, Chuuk, Kosrae, Pohnpei, and Yap, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Purpose. Pursuant to section 216 of the
- 2 Compact of Free Association between FSM and the USA, the amount
- 3 of sector grant funding received by FSM began decreasing in
- 4 2007 at the rate of \$800,000 per year. This annual decrease is
- 5 often referred to as "the decrement" and has been a cause of
- 6 alarm for government administrators as their funding has
- 7 decreased annually over the last five years and will continue
- 8 to decrease until 2023. The only long-term solution for FSM
- 9 and its component states is to become a fully self-sustaining
- 10 administration through fostering private sector growth and
- 11 implementing a sensible tax collection plan, which generates
- 12 sufficient funds without reliance on outside assistance. Yet,
- 13 Congress is concerned that immediate anxiety over the decrement
- 14 could distract from state governments' focus on implementing
- 15 the kind of long-ranging reforms needed to put FSM and its
- 16 component states on the road to self-sufficiency. Thus,
- 17 Congress is appropriating this one-time infusion of money to
- 18 allay fears over the decrement for the next five years.

        Section 2. The sum of $5,000,000, or so much thereof as
