A BILL FOR AN ACT

To enact a title 28 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, to establish a Chamber of Traditional Chiefs, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. A new title 28 is hereby added to the Code
- 2 of the Federated States of Micronesia, entitled "TITLE 28:
- 3 CHAMBER OF TRADITIONAL CHIEFS."
- 4 Section 2. A section 101 of title 28 of the Code of
- 5 the Federated States of Micronesia is enacted to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 "Section 101. Statement of purpose.
- 8 The people of the many islands of the Federated
- 9 <u>States of Micronesia have unique and ancient</u>
- 10 cultures comprised of diverse traditions and
- 11 customs. These traditions and customs should be
- 12 respected and preserved. In order to do this a
- 13 <u>Chamber of Traditional Chiefs shall be created.</u>
- 14 <u>This Chamber of Traditional Chiefs shall advise</u>
- 15 the National and State Governments for the purpose
- of strengthening and encouraging the customs and
- 17 <u>traditions of the people of the Federated States</u>
- of Micronesia."
- 19 Section 3. A section 102 of title 28 of the Code of
- 20 the Federated States of Micronesia is enacted to read as

1	follows:
2	"Section 102. Composition of the Chamber of
3	Traditional Chiefs.
4	The Chamber of Traditional Chiefs shall consist of
5	four traditional chiefs from each state.
6	Selection of the traditional chiefs shall be
7	consistent with that particular state's unique
8	tradition. In states with no traditional chiefs
9	the state legislature shall select four
10	individuals to represent the interests of their
11	state's traditions and customs in the Chamber."
12	Section 4. A new section 108 of title 28 of the Code
13	of the Federated States of Micronesia is enacted to read
14	as follows:
15	"Section 103. Powers and duties.
16	The Chamber of Traditional Chiefs shall have the
17	following powers and duties:
18	(1) to provide advice to the National and State
19	Governments regarding the encouraging and
20	strengthening of the traditions and customs of
21	the people of the Federated States of Micronesia;
22	(2) to monitor the activities of the National
23	and State Governments and their agencies which
24	could have an impact on traditions and customs;
25	(3) to participate in Nation-wide leadership

forums, including the state and national 1 leadership conferences; 3 (4) to prepare and submit a report at least 4 once a year to the President, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, and the Supreme 5 Court of the Federated States of Micronesia, as 6 7 well as, the executive, legislature, and judiciary branches of each state, setting forth the 8 activities of the Chamber during the period since 9 its last report and its plans for future 10 activities; 11 (5) to establish facilities and acquire 12 13 equipment and supplies as may be necessary for the 14 effective implementation of its mandate, taking all reasonable steps to quard against unnecessary 15 duplication of facilities and materials at the 16 national and state levels; 17 18 (6) to prepare and promulgate rules, 19 regulations, and guidelines necessary to the effective implementation of this section; and 20 21 (7) to engage in such other activities as are 22 not inconsistent with the purposes of this title." Section 5. A section 104 of title 28 of the Code of 2.3 the Federated States of Micronesia is enacted to read as 24 25 follows:

1	"Section 104. Compensation.
2	Members of the Chamber of Traditional Chiefs shall
3	be entitled to compensation as to be determined by
4	law. In addition, all members of the Chamber of
5	Traditional Chiefs shall be paid per diem and
6	travel expenses at standard government rates
7	incidental to travel required to fulfill their
8	responsibilities under this title."
9	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by
10	the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
11	its becoming law without such approval.
