A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1,2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 12 of Public Law No. 17-19 in order to appropriate supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to align the budget act with the recent Compact Grant Awards, to introduce technical amendments concerning the allottee of funding; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
