A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1 and 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Law No. 17-28, in order to appropriate an additional \$41,809 from the General Fund in supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

16		Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall
17		be deemed to come from funds available under the
18		Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be
19		deemed to come from funds available under the amended

1 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt 2 of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598 3 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds 5 available under the amended Compact from the private sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be 7 deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the infrastructure sector. 9 10 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended 11 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows: "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. 12 The sum of $\{[9,476,230], 9,518,039, or so much\}$ 13 14 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated 15 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 16 2012, for the following grants, subsidies and 17 contributions during fiscal year 2012. Of the total 18 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be 19 deemed to come from funds available under the amended 20 21 Compact from the education sector; and \$-0- shall be 22 deemed to come from funds available under the 23 Supplemental Education Grant.
