Dear Speaker Figir:

I designated the following congressional act to become Public Law No. 17-69 pursuant to Article IX Section 22 of the FSM Constitution:

CONGRESSIONAL ACT NO. 17-67: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 1, 2, 3, 8, AND 12 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-64 IN ORDER TO APPROPRIATE \$2,253,200 IN SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2013; TO ALIGN THE BUDGET ACT WITH AMENDED COMPACT GRANT AWARDS AND SUPPLEMENTAL EDUCATION GRANT AWARD; TO ASSIGN AN ALLOTTEE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I wish to thank Congress for approving the FY2013 Supplemental Budget during the last special session. I must also point out that equally-urgent supplemental budget requests have remained pending, which must be addressed as soon as possible. Enclosed is the listing of the requests:

I recommend that Congress consider them at the earliest opportunity during the regular session in January 2013.

Moreover, I recommend that the following errors in the Act be rectified: (a) allottee for the travel funds for the Members of Congress, should be the Speaker, not the President; (b) allottee for the Reimbursement to EU should be the President; and (c) section 9 should be mentioned in the title.
