Dear Speaker Figir:



I am pleased to inform you that I have designated the following Congressional Act as Public Law No. 17-12:

Congressional Act No. 17-13, "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 15-32, AS AMENDED, BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03, 16-11, 16-33 AND 16-46, BY AMENDING SECTION 1 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR THE STATE OF POHNPEI, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Although I have signed the act into law, I am quite concern and disturb with the string of changes in the use of funds previously appropriated for public projects and social programs. The continuous changes in the use of these funds are a clear indication of inadequate planning on our part as policy makers. I respectfully request that we reexamine the Nation's policy on public project appropriation, to avoid appearance of weakness in government planning practices as shown by the constant amendment to public laws.

PUBLIC LAW No. 17-12

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-32, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-36, 15-44, 15-57, 15-63, 15-72, 15-78, 16-03, 16-11, 16-33 and 16-46, by amending section 1 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein for the State of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
