PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-67

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$5,697,383 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, for the purpose of paying the amount owed by the State Governments to FEMA and to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes. BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

9 Section 1. The sum of \$5,697,383, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the 10 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 11 12 September 30, 2013, for the purpose of paying the amount owed by the State Governments to FEMA and to fund public projects and 13 social programs in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk. 14 15 The funds appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows: 16

Section 2. Of the sum of \$5,697,383 appropriated by this act, \$284,210 is apportioned to pay the amount owed by the State of Yap to FEMA and \$600,000 is apportioned for public projects and social programs in the State of Yap.
