PUBLIC LAW NO. 17-88

AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 3 and 9 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, in order to appropriate \$3,524,541 in supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, to make a technical amendment, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended by
Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, is hereby further amended to
read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Of the 13 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$4,252,868 14 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the education sector subject to the 15 16 receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; 17 \$1,168,765 shall be deemed to come from funds available 18 under the Supplemental Education Grant; \$895,705 shall

2	Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt of
3	Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$-0- shall be
4	deemed to come from funds available under the amended
5	Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be

9	under the amended Compact from the enhanced reporting

13	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 17-64, as amended
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14 by Public Laws Nos. 17-69 and 17-74, is hereby further amended 15 to read as follows:

"Section 3. Operating Expenses of the Legislative 16 Branch. The sum of \$3,480,228 or so much thereof as 17 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the 18 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 19 20 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, for the operations of the Legislative Branch of the 21 22 National Government during fiscal year 2013. The sum 23 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows: 24
