## A RESOLUTION

To ratify the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization Convention for the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage.

WHEREAS, the main objective of the United Nations
Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization Convention for
the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage (the
"Convention") is to preserve intangible cultural heritage and thus
a people's sense of identify; and

6 WHEREAS, being rich in cultural heritage, the Federated 7 States of Micronesia has some of the last remaining traditional 8 navigators in the Pacific within the outer islands of Yap and 9 Chuuk, whose knowledge in canoe building and navigation are in 10 danger of extinction if not properly preserved; and

11 WHEREAS, ratifying the Convention allows the Federated States 12 of Micronesia to benefit from the pool of experts in preserving 13 intangible cultural heritage and from the mutual cooperation among 14 State Parties; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventeenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2012, that Congress hereby ratifies the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization Convention for the Safeguarding of
