
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 203 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-55, 15-09 and 15-74, for the purpose of transferring the Compact Management Office under the Department of Foreign Affairs, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 203 of title 2 of the Code of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 10-55, 15-09
3 and 15-74, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 203. Departments.

5 (1) There shall be the following departments which
6 shall be responsible for major programs or
7 administrative support areas in the Government of the
8 Federated States of Micronesia:

9 (a) Department of Resources and Development;

10 (b) Department of Finance and Administration;

11 (c) Department of Foreign Affairs; which shall
12 include the Compact Management Office

13 (d) Department of Health and Social Affairs;

14 (e) Department of Justice;

15 (f) Department of Transportation, Communication
16 and Infrastructure, which shall contain among other
17 units, a Project Management Unit for the Compact
18 Infrastructure Grants; and

19 (g) Department of Education.

1 (2) The administrative head of each department shall
2 be designated as a "Secretary".

3 (3) The administrative head of each office shall be
4 designated as a "Director".

5 (4) Succession.

6 (a) Any reference to a previously existing
7 department, office or division thereof shall apply to
8 the appropriate successor entity.

9 (b) Any reference to any office or employee of an
10 entity referred to in subsection (4)(a) of this section
11 shall be construed as applying to the person holding the
12 same or most similar position in the appropriate
13 successor entity."

14 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
16 becoming law without such approval.
