

A RESOLUTION

To confirm the nomination of Mr. Ignacio Stephen to the position of FSM Consul General in Honolulu, Hawaii.

1           WHEREAS, during the Third Regular Session of the Seventeenth  
2 Congress, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia  
3 submitted the nomination of Mr. Ignacio Stephen to serve as the  
4 FSM Consul General in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

5           WHEREAS, the resolution approving that nomination had not  
6 been adopted and, under 2 F.S.M.C. §207, the nomination may not be  
7 resubmitted by the President during the Seventeenth Congress  
8 without authorization from Congress; and

9           WHEREAS, pursuant to Congressional Resolution No. 17-139, the  
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia is authorized to  
11 resubmit the nomination of Mr. Ignacio Stephen to serve as the FSM  
12 Consul General in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

13           WHEREAS, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia  
14 has resubmitted the nomination of Mr. Ignacio Stephen to serve as  
15 the FSM Consul General in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

16           WHEREAS, Mr. Stephen possesses the relevant experience and  
17 qualifications to serve as the FSM Consul General in Honolulu,  
18 Hawaii; now, therefore,

19           BE IT RESOLVED by the Seventeenth Congress of the Federated  
20 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2012, that Congress  
21 hereby confirms the nomination of Mr. Ignacio Stephen to serve as

1 the FSM Consul General in Honolulu, Hawaii; and

2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
3 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States  
4 of Micronesia, the FSM Secretary of Foreign Affairs, the Governor  
5 of each State of the Nation, and Mr. Ignacio Stephen.
