A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$2,000,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, to loan to the Pohnpei Utilities Corporation, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide an interest-free loan to
- 2 the Pohnpei Utilities Corporation.
- 3 Section 2. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 4 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
- 5 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
- 6 ending September 30, 2013, to be loaned to the Pohnpei
- 7 Utilities Corporation. Such loan shall bear no interest and is
- 8 to be repaid in full within ten (10) years, though no payments
- 9 shall be due for the first three (3) years.
- 10 Section 3. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
- 11 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
- 12 managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
- 13 applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial
- 14 Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for
- 15 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
- 16 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
- 17 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
- 18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
- 19 section 1 of this act shall be the President of the Federated

   obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
   September 30, 2023.

   President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
 6 becoming law without such approval.
