A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$1,856,752 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1, 3, and 8 of Public Law No. 18-15, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
