A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 15-80, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-04 and 17-53, by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein for public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Allotment and management of funds and lapse date. 9 (1) General Provisions. 10 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall 11 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for 12 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. 13 14 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for 15 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose 16 specified in this act, and that no obligations are 17 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. 18 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds 19 appropriated by this act are as follows: 20 (a) Subsection 1 of Section 1 - the allottee 21 22 of these funds shall be the President of the 23 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; (b) Subsection 2 of Section 1 - the allottee 24 25 of these funds shall be the Governor of Yap State or

his designee, PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds 1 2 under subsections 1(2)(a), 1(2)(c)(i) and 1(2)(c)(ii) 3 of this Act shall be the President of the College of Micronesia - FSM; 4 (c) Subsection 3 of Section 1 - the allottee 5 of these funds shall be the President of the 6 7 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; (d) [Subsection 4 of Section 1 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chuuk State Commission on 9 10 Improvement Projects | Subsection 4(a) and 4(c) of Section 1 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his 11 12 designee; Subsection 4(b) of Section 1 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority; Subsection 13 4(d) of Section 1 shall be the Southern Namoneas 14 Development Authority; Subsection 4(e) of Section 1 15 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority; 16 Subsection 4(f) of Section 1 shall be the Northwest 17 Islands Development Authority; 18 (e) Subsection 5 of Section 1 - the allottee 19 of these funds shall be the President of the 20 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. 21 22 (3) <u>Lapse Date</u>. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall [not] 23 lapse [until fully expended] on September 30, 2015." 24 25
