Section 5. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-35 is hereby

"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
State provided that the allottee of funds appropriated
under section 2(e) shall be the President of COM-FSM.
The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4
of this act shall be the President of the Federated
States of Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the
