## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate a supplemental budget of \$447,486 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, by amending sections 1, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-26 and 18-41, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by 2 Public Laws Nos. 18-26 and 18-41, is hereby further amended to 3 read as follows:

Title. The title of this act is as 4 "Section 1. 5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$[56,585,943] 57,033,429 from the General Fund of the Federated States 6 7 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014, for the purpose of funding the operations of all 8 branches of the National Government of the Federated 9 10 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, 11 grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and 12 Human Resources Development. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein,  $\left\{\frac{2,400,000}{2,437,568}\right\}$  shall 13 be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended 14 Compact from the education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed 15 16 to come from funds available under the Amended Compact 17 from the health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the 18 infrastructure sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from 19

1 funds available under the Amended Compact from the 2 public sector capacity building; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from 3 the enhanced reporting and accountability sector; and 4 5 \$1,112,158 shall be deemed to come from funds available 6 under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum 7 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:" Section 8 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by 8 Section 2. Public Laws Nos. 18-26 and 18-41, is hereby further amended to 9 read as follows: 10

"Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. 11 The sum of \$[<del>11,525,280</del>] <u>11,563,198</u>, or so much thereof as 12 13 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for 14 15 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2014 for the following grants, subsidies and contributions during 16 17 fiscal year 2014. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be deemed to come from 18 funds available under the Amended Compact from the 19 20 education sector. The sum appropriated by this section 21 shall be apportioned as follows:
