A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 9 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-41 and 18-54, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 9 of Public Law No. 18-15, as amended by Section 1.

3 Public Laws Nos. 18-41 and 18-54, is hereby further amended to

4 read as follows:

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"Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development. The sum of \$19,845,792 or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year 8 ending September 30, 2014, for the following capital 9 10 improvements, development programs, and projects and human resources development. Of the total amount of funds 11 12 appropriated herein, \$2,437,568 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the Amended Compact from the 13 14 education sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds 15 available under the Amended Compact from the health sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available 16 under the Amended Compact from public capacity building 17 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available 18 under the Amended Compact from the infrastructure sector; 19 \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under 20 21 the Amended Compact from the enhanced reporting and

1	accountability sector; and \$799,666 shall be deemed to		
2	come from funds available under the Supplemental Education
